OUR FIRST MEETING WITH SOUTHWARK AS A JV PARTNER

On the 19th of April, Riverside and Mount Anvil met with Southwark planners for the first time as a Joint Venture partnership regarding the new planning application. Southwark planners were pleased to hear the excellent result of the first resident vote of support and were equally happy to hear that a second resident vote on scheme proposals will be happening prior to the submission of the planning application.

Southwark Council have asked us to provide them with additional information before we meet with them again. This means there's more work we need to do before we commence resident workshops and the new scheme design. We are now working hard to prepare the additional information required and we will keep you updated on progress.
