



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## LAVISHAM HOUSE CAR PARK





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### PARKING MANAGEMENT



27 car parking bays, of which 4 will be wheelchair accessible.

The area behind Lavisham House will be fenced off

All entrances to Lavisham House will continue to be operational as usual

How will the spaces be allocated?

How will the parking be managed? The spaces within the car park will accommodate the closure of parking at Wells House and Burnt Ash Heights. Wheelchair accessible users will need to display their blue badges.

Riverside will monitor usage of available spaces closely and will consider parking enforcement options if necessary. We will also carry out a consultation exercise during construction to understand what the wider estate would like to see in terms of



parking management going forward.
