The new development

- —170 new homes (92 affordable, 78 private)
- —4 blocks of flats from 8 to 13 storeys
- —2 rows of houses


Block B (Private) – 13 storeys

Block D (Lavisham) – 8 storeys

Block C (Mede, Wells and Burnt Ash Heights) – 9 storeys Block E (Social Rent, London Affordable Rent & Private) – 3 storeys

Block A (Burnt Ash Heights) – 8 storeys

Block F (Social rent, London Affordable Rent & Private) – 2 storeys



Energy centre move

Riverside and Countryside have approval from Bromley Council to move the energy centre from Block B into Block C.

This brings forward the energy centre to Phase 1 (rather than Phase 2), reducing the disruption to residents as it means temporary energy supplies will be no longer required in the newly built blocks.

Block C - updated ground floor plan


The changes to the ground floor to Block C to accommodate the energy centre mean that there will be a slight change to the mix of properties in this block:

- 1 of the 3-bedroom maisonettes has been replaced by a 3-bedroom apartment
- 2 of the 2-bedroom apartments have been replaced with 1-bedroom apartments.

In keeping with the original design, the ground floor of Block C still has cycle storage and a refuse store for the use of residents in this block only.
