Amie Wells “Hello, I am the Housing Officer for Walton/County Road, Rice Lane, Walton Vale and parts of Fazakerley.

Where can you find me? Catch me at the Blue Base on Salop Street, L4 4BZ every Thursday between 10am – 12pm. Please feel free to pop along to introduce yourself, for a free brew or to discuss any issues you may have relating to your tenancy.”



Neil Robinson “I cover L11, L12 (Deysbrook area) & L13 (St Oswald Street area). I have worked in a variety of housing roles across Riverside for over 30 years.

Where can you find me? I hold a housing drop-in surgery every third Thursday of each month at the Deysbrook Centre, situated on Deysbrook Way L12.”



Natalie Daley “I am a Housing Officer working in North Liverpool and I cover the Kirkdale and Vauxhall area (L4 & L5).

Where can you find me? Athol Village surgery takes place on the first Thursday of each month at the Riverside Your Place Office, 2 Leigh Bridge Way, L5 9RH between 10.30am – 12.30pm. No appointment needed and all Riverside tenants are welcome to drop in for advice and support with tenancy related issues.”



Yasmin McCormack “I have been a Housing Officer at Riverside for seven years. I cover parts of L3, L5 and L6.

Where can you find me? At St George’s Church, Everton on alternate Fridays from 4th April between 9am – 11am, and West Everton Community Centre (WECC) fortnightly alternating between Wednesdays and Fridays starting from Wednesday 16th April. 1pm – 2.30pm.”



Trish Jacobson “I am the Housing Officer for the Lakes Streets and the L5 postcode. I also cover parts of L4 and L6.

Where can you find me? Pop in and see me at the Breckfield Centre, Breckfield Road North fortnightly on Tuesdays from 18th March 10am – 12pm. I also attend St George’s Church, Everton, on alternate Fridays from 4th April between 9am – 11am.”

St Georges Pantry, fortnightly on a Friday 9:00 to 11:00 from April 2025.



Sharon Mordecai “I have worked for Riverside for 12 years and have been a Housing Officer for six years. I cover the Tuebrook L6, Clubmoor L13 and Old Swan L13 areas.”

Where can you find me? At ‘New Beginnings Improving Lives’, 63 Rocky Lane from 9.30am – 12pm on the first Friday of the month; ‘An Hour for Others’, 659 Derby Lane on the 3rd Friday of the month 3pm – 5pm; and at Lister Steps Old Library between 11.30am – 12.30pm on the second Wednesday of the month.”



Eirini Tsiotis “Hi, I am the Housing Officer for L7 and parts of L6, mainly covering Fairfield in Kensington. I have been in this role for two and a half years, supporting residents with their housing needs and tenancy related issues.

Where can you find me? I hold a monthly drop-in session on the last Thursday of each month from 3pm – 5pm at Kensington Children’s Centre.”
